**Entry:** Postal and email entries only will be accepted. Entries close with the Secretary on the 27 July 2018

**Ballot:** This trial will be limited to 18 dogs. A draw will take place at 5pm on 3 August 2018 at CareVets Central, 574 Anglesea Street, Hamilton

**Draw:** The draw will be notified to entering competitors by the 6 August 2017.

**Starting time:** Assemble at 9.00am at the main entrance on the roadside. No entering onto property until authorised by the trials' captain. TBC

#### **Conditions of entry:**

1. The trial will be conducted under the rules and Regulations for the Conduct of Spaniel Natural Game Trials as approved by the N.Z.G.T.A. A copy of the regulations will be available at the trial from the Secretary.
2. All dogs entered in the trial must be purebred spaniels and registered on the N.Z.K.C. number 1 or number 3 register.
3. All competitors must be financial members of the Working Spaniel Club or any N.Z.G.T.A. affiliated club and not have any outstanding amounts owing to the Working Spaniel Club.
4. The trial manager reserves the right to make any alteration to this schedule to meet any emergency.
5. All competitors and their dogs compete at their own risk.
6. All shooters should be in possession of their current Firearms Licence and 2017 Game licence
7. Hi viz hat and/vest to be worn by all participants.
