SPANIEL NATURAL GAME CHAMPIONSHIP TRIAL

Venue: 2136 Taihape Road, Sherenden (Tuna Nui)

Date: 23 August 2022

Entry Fee: \$60.00 per dog or WSC/SIWSC members, which includes \$5 N.Z.G.T.A. levy per dog. This is a contracted trial with the Tuna Nui, payment is to be made in full, with your entry application and is non-refundable. Payment to be made into WSC account - ANZ 11-6001-0088881-11, noting in the reference fields, TNAug22 and your name

Entry: Postal and email entries only will be accepted. Entries close with the Field Trial Secretary on the 30 July 2022

Ballot: This trial will be limited to 18 dogs. A draw will take place at Dechra Vets, 198A Kapiti Road, Paraparaumu 5032 on Monday 01 August 2022

Draw: The draw will be notified to entering competitors by the 08 August 2022

Starting time: Assemble at 8.00am at Wool Shed

Conditions of entry:

1. The trial will be conducted under the rules and Regulations for the Conduct of Spaniel Natural Game Trials as approved by the NZGTA. A copy of the regulations will be available at the trial from the Secretary.
2. All dogs entered in the trial must be purebred spaniels and registered on the NZKC No.1 or No.3 Register.

3. **As this is a sheep farm, please ensure that your dog/s have been treated for sheep measles tapeworm and a current dosing certificate is made available at the trial grounds on the day**
4. All competitors must be financial members of the Working Spaniel Club or any NZGTA affiliated club and have no outstanding fees owing to the Working Spaniel Club at the time of entry.
5. The Trial Manager reserves the right to make any alteration to this schedule to meet any emergency.
6. All competitors and their dogs compete at their own risk.
7. All shooters must be in possession of their current Firearms Licence
8. All guns and competitors must be in possession of the 2022 Game Licence
9. Hi-vis hat and/or vest to be worn by all participants.
10. Guns will read safety recommendations prior to the trial. These will be provided by Trials Manager

Trophies: One challenge point may be awarded to the winner at the discretion of the judges. Ribbons for first, second and third placed dogs.
