Reef sired multiple successful working gundogs and two of his sons have won the New Zealand Retriever Championship. Like Reef, Richie has left an ongoing legacy within the NZ Gundog scene and this special trial is held annually in his memory by SAGDC, friends and family.*

1. If entries exceed 12 dogs, those who have not placed in an open walkup trial will be balloted.
2. If required, the ballot will be held at Tuakau Hotel, 1-3 George Street, Tuakau at 7:30pm 4<sup>th</sup> October in accordance with NZGTA rules. Entry list will be advised shortly thereafter.
3. Eligible dogs must be retrievers and registered on the Dogs NZ Purebred Dog Registry (Part I or Part III).
4. Registration numbers to be supplied with championship entries.
5. Trial to be run under the Walk-up Rules & Regulations of the NZGTA. These rules will be on display.
6. Competitors must be a current financial member of an NZGTA affiliated club.
7. All competitors / visitors and dogs attend at their own risk. Obstacles identified where possible.
8. Exercise area will be designated.
9. No late entries will be accepted.
