1. For all championship events, all dogs must be purebred & registered on the NZKC No. 1 or No. 3 Register.
2. Registration numbers must be supplied with championship entries.
3. Trials to be run under the Rules & Regulations of the NZGTA. These rules will be available on site.
4. All competitors must be a current financial member of an affiliated club.
5. All competitors / visitors and dogs compete and attend at their own risk.
6. The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to this schedule to meet any unforeseen circumstances.
7. There must be 5 or more entries for a 2nd prize to be awarded and a minimum of 8 entries for a 3rd prize to be awarded.
8. No late or unpaid entries will be accepted.
9. Hazardous obstacles on the ground will be notified to competitors, however this is a live hunting event and competitors must accept that some risk may be present in these circumstances.
