NEW ZEALAND GUNDOG FIELD TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, 2024

25th, 26th & 27th October 2024

Start time: 8.30am each day

Order of running:

Friday	Retriever Walk Up, Novice Walk Up
Saturday	All Breeds (water first), Novice, Puppy, Retriever 1 (Land), P&S
Sunday	Retriever 2 (Water), Limit, Spaniel, Retriever 3 (Land/Water)

Rules & Regulations:

- 1) All championship dogs must be purebred & registered NZKC No. 1
- 2) Minor trials are open to all dogs (NZKC No. 1 Register, or No. 2 Register, or unregistered)
- 3) Schedule approved & trials run under rules & regulations of the NZGTA.
- 4) All competitors must be financial members of an affiliated club.
- 5) No late or unpaid entries will be accepted.
- 6) Competitors who fail to be on the mark when required are liable to disqualification.
- 7) All dogs entered at the owners' risk.
- 8) All dogs must be on a lead unless competing or in designated exercise area.
- 9) Penalty for breach of Reg. Gen. 7c is \$20.00. (NZGTA rule book page 25)
- 10) Engraving to be the responsibility & cost of the winner.
- 11) The committee reserves the right to make changes to meet unforeseen circumstances.
- 12) Full pedigree name and registration number must be supplied at time of entry.
- 13) Eight or more dogs to be entered for third place trophy to be awarded, 12 or more dogs to be entered for fourth place trophy to be awarded, 16 or more dogs to be entered for fifth place trophy to be awarded.

NZ CHAMPIONSHIP SPECIAL TROPHIES:

Thorburn Cup (donated in 1967 by S A Thorburn). Highest aggregate score in All Breeds & Breed event at NZ Champs

James Reid Memorial Cup (donated in 1963 by J & G Reid) Spaniel gaining most points in All Breeds at NZ Champs.

Shadow Cup (donated in 1983 by K E Helson). Retriever gaining highest aggregate score in NZ & Island (that is held in conjunction with NZ Champs) Retriever Championship

Jim Reid Memorial Trophy (donated in 1997 by Jocelyn Reid). For the Spaniel gaining most points in All Breeds at New Zealand Championship.

Tom Catherall Memorial Trophy (donated in 1999 by the Catherall family). For the non-champion spaniel gaining the highest aggregate points in the NZ All Breeds and NZ Spaniel Championship Field Trials

Bill Streeter Memorial Trophy (donated in 1992 by Mrs. M Streeter). To be presented annually to the nonchampion dog gaining the highest aggregate points in the NZ All Breeds and NZ Retriever Championship Field Trials.

Champion of Champions (donated in 1981 by W K Donaldson and family). Competitors at NZ Championship being FTCh, GFTCh, FCh or GFCh gaining highest aggregate score in All Breeds and Breed events. Entries to be made to the secretary by 7:30am on the first day of the trial. Entry Fee \$1.

Cornhill Shield (donated in 1949 by J Penno). For competition between clubs in NZ All Breeds Championship. Clubs may nominate three dogs and one reserve (one team only). All owners to be financial members of nominating club. All entries to be in writing from club secretary and accompanied by entry fee of \$1 per team member. Entries close with the host secretary by 7:30am on the first day of the trial.

Inter-Island Trophy (donated in 1988 by W A Streeter). Teams of 4 dogs and 1 reserve from each island. Dogs can run in any class – All Breeds, Retriever, Pointer Setter, and Spaniel. Clubs or persons may nominate any dog or dogs that have performed to their satisfaction. This nomination must be received by the Association Secretary 1 month before the NZ Champs. North Island Executive will select North Island team; South Island Executive will select South Island team.

John Gaskin Memorial Trophy (donated by R Gaskin, 2007)

Calculated over all Natural Game Championship Trials throughout the year, from the Island Championship immediately preceding the New Zealand Championships to the last championship prior to this trial in the following year.

Coveybrooke Memorial Cup (donated by Graeme Palmer and Sonya Tamblyn 2016)

Calculated over all Retriever Walk-up and Natural Game Retriever Championship Trials throughout the year, from the Island Championship immediately preceding the New Zealand Championships to the last championship prior to this trial in the following year.

Bruce Brady Memorial (donated by the Brady family). Presented to the Retriever gaining most points calculated over all Retriever Championship Trials (Natural Game Retriever, Retriever Walkup and Retriever) throughout the year, from the Island Championship immediately preceding the New Zealand Championships to the last championship prior to this trial in the following year.

Gordon Clarke Trophy (donated by the Clarke Family, 2009): Presented to the All Breeds dog gaining the most points calculated over all - All Breeds Range, Find and Flush Championship Trials throughout the year from Island Championship immediately preceding the New Zealand Championships to the last championship prior to this trial in the following year.

FTCH Levenghyl Pirate Memorial Trophy (donated by R and S Buddle 2017) Calculated on all Novice Walkup Retriever and Novice Natural Game trials throughout the year from the Island Championship immediately preceding the New Zealand Championships to the last trial prior to this trial in the following year.

NZ Gundog of the Year Trophy (donated anonymously). Presented to the dog that gains the most challenge points (National trials not included) during the year – AGM to AGM.

The Reddawn Cup (donated by M and R Weir, 2023) presented to the winner of the New Zealand Retriever Walk Up Championship.
